Why UNI?

UNI Educational Psychology, Foundations and Leadership Studies is a department with impact; nearly 40 percent of Iowa's school administrators are alumni of our programs, including the Principalship MAE/ASC.

Award-winning faculty who have led and practiced in the field, and who have conducted a wide array of research, are now your teachers and mentors as you seek to advance your school administrative career.

This two-year program is designed for those seeking endorsement in the state of Iowa as a PK-12 Principal/PK-12 Supervisor of Special Education (Iowa Endorsement #189 and #190). The performance-based program is unique in that it minimizes student class time and maximizes on-site skill development while working with mentors and UNI faculty. Students gain hands-on experience through an internship where work products and skills are developed.

Program features

- Program requirements and outcomes based on Iowa leadership standards
- Program completion in 2 years – 35 units of graduate credit via 13 courses and extensive internship experiences
- Students are provided a mentor, a field supervisor, and an advisor to assist in successful and timely completion of the program.
